**Connect: Grow together**

1. How did God show up in your life this week?
2. What are you thankful for since the last time we met? Stressed about?
3. Did you follow through on any action steps from last time? How did it go?

**Discover: Let the words sink in**

1. What was the main point of this week's message, in your own words?
2. What jumped out at you?
3. What did this message say about God and about people? If this is true and you acted on it, how might this change your life?
4. How will you apply what you learned before we meet again?
5. Create an "I will" statement based on the message.

**Challenge Questions:**

1. How do you define success? How have you found yourself actually thinking about success?
2. What do Jesus' words in Matthew 22v37-40 reveal about true success?
3. How have the last few weeks influenced or challenged your view of success?
4. In II Kings 5v1-12, Naaman sought a cure through using his status, letters of recommendation, and his money. In what ways have you pursued healing or cures to brokenness in your life?
5. Are you willing to accept the costly grace of Jesus? How is this acceptance a one time acceptance? How is this acceptance continual?
6. On Sunday, Grant asked, "Are you willing to allow the Holy Spirit to reshape your mindset and your desires as it relates to how you pursue a successful life?" What do you think this would look like?
