4. What has your wealth done to you in different seasons of your life?
5. Have you thought through what it could look like to pursue justice and mercy with your income and spending? What has that looked like if so?
6. Do you truly believe you have submitted your finance to Christ?
7. How does Christ's action on the cross inform our understanding of generosity?
