### 02 DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. What is your familiarity with the Lord's prayer? Is this prayer something you had never heard of until Sunday, something you were forced to repeat growing up, or somewhere in the middle? How do you think your familiarity with the Lord's prayer influences the way you think about it?
2. Do you agree that prayer is uncomplicated in its nature? Why or why not? What do you think it means that it is uncomplicated in its nature but eternal in its depth?
3. The Lord's prayer starts with "Our Father" rather than any alternative terms. What do you think it means that the Lord's prayer starts with familial language rather than consumeristic language?
4. Have you ever thought about yourself as an ambassador for Christ? How do you think the idea of being an ambassador for Christ relates to the portion of the prayer that says, "May your name be kept holy"?
5. How would your life be impacted if you thought about the reality that you carry God's name with you?
6. What obstacles have been getting in the way of your prayer life? Which of those obstacles could you find a way to navigate around?
7. When was the last time you set aside a portion of time to sit in awe before God? Take time as a group to prayerfully be still before him.

### 03 CHALLENGE QUESTIONS:

1. Do you think that everyone is a child of God? Why or why not?
2. How would it influence your life if you turned your phone off for one hour each day, and one day each week? Would you be willing to try that this week?
