3. If your biblical knowledge does nothing to save your soul, what is the value in growing in your knowledge of Scripture?
4. On Sunday, Pastor Grant presented three types of lies we often fall into about our identity. The first causes us to look to what we do to find our identity, the second causes us to search for our identity in what people say about us, and the third results in our attempt to find our identity in the things we have. How have these stories impacted you throughout your life?
5. How does Scripture help us as we navigate our responses to these three kinds of lies we encounter?
6. What could you do this week to grow in how you interact with and treat Scripture?

1. Set aside a moment to take an individual "Inventory of the soul" and ask yourself, "Who are you becoming?"
2. Take a moment as a group to talk through what came to mind as you reflected on who you are becoming.
