SCRIPTURE REFERENCE:

ICE BREAKER:

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. What was most interesting to you in Sunday's sermon?
2. How have you seen people (yourself or others) struggle when they don't know who they are in Christ?
3. In your experience, why do we typically believe lies about our identity?
4. Read through Ephesians 1:1-14 slowly, in a few different translations and write down everything we are in Christ. Then compare your list to your group members. What similarities and differences do you see in the lists as you read them?
5. If someone asked you, "Who are you and who told you that?" What would your response be?
6. All of the Ephesians 1 passage is predicated on being "in Christ." What do you understand that to mean and how do you see it explained/described in scripture?
7. If you're comfortable, share a false identity you either have struggled with in the past, or are currently battling. Take a few minutes and pray Truth and healing over these areas for each other.

CHALLENGE QUESTIONS:

1. If being united with Christ means we are also united in the love and intimacy of the Trinity, how does that affect how you understand and engage God? Does it change how you relate to each member of the Trinity? Why or why not?
2. How does being, “holy and blameless” in God’s eyes relate to repentance? Is it still necessary? Why or why not?
