DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Steph Curry revolutionized basketball. Jesus revolutionized life itself! How have you experienced new life in Christ?
2. Read Luke 6:20-26. How do you understand and explain the concept of “blessing” in your life as a Jesus follower?
3. How do you define/articulate the idea of “love” in our culture today? Read Luke 6:27-35. How would you describe “love” in the Kingdom of God? Why do you think there’s such a radical difference between the two?
4. What does it look like, for you personally, to “love your enemy” and to, “bless those who curse you?” Not just in general, but in your particular life, in this particular moment.
5. Read Luke 6:41-42. Admitting our weaknesses and shortcomings can be difficult, but your community group is a safe place, so allow yourself to be vulnerable; what

“logs” typically blind you? What sin is easy for you to ignore in your own life while never failing to see it in other’s lives?

6. Knowing it is the Holy Spirit who ultimately produces fruit in us (see Gal 5:22-23), and that the human heart is deceitful above all things (see Jer 17:5-10), how is Luke 6:43-45 actually lived out by us, today?

CHALLENGE QUESTION:

1. Assuming a literal reading of Luke 6:20-26, what is the blessing Jesus is speaking over the poor, hungry and weeping? Why is there sorrow awaiting the rich, fat and prosperous, laughing, and those praised by the crowd?
2. If the life and teachings of Jesus are to be the model for every moment of our lives, how does that look in your day to day?
