## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

- 3. John 13v3-15 recounts the moment Jesus decided to serve his disciples by washing their feet. If feet were particularly dirty and unappealing in ancient Israel, what does it reveal about Jesus when he steps toward his disciples to serve them in this way?
- 4. What do you think of the idea, "God has never mistreated you a day in your life"?
- 5. Have your feelings toward God always been aligned with how you answered the previous question? If there are moments where your feelings toward God aren't aligned with what you think is true about him, how have you stepped toward walking with a healthy perspective?
- 6. Do you think that service must begin with a willingness to be served by Christ? Why or why not?
- 7. What do you think of the claim, "If serving others is beneath you, apprenticeship to Jesus is beyond you"?
- 8. Who are you serving? Why are you serving them?

## **CHALLENGE QUESTIONS:**

- 1. Is truly altruistic service possible? Why or why not?
- 2. In what area of your life does your view of serving those around you need to be reoriented and adjusted?
