ICE BREAKER:

1. What is something you worked for, built, or made but found it to be less than you expected once you finally had it?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

2. When Jesus called Simon, Andrew, James, John, and Levi (Matthew), what was he asking them to do?
3. What did the disciples expect when they followed Jesus?
4. Where has following Jesus placed meaning and purpose in your life? Where haven't you allowed that to happen?
5. Pastor Grant mentioned what he knew about the beginning of Summit as a church and the results of others following Jesus. Can you see those results at Summit or elsewhere?
6. Consider what you do today, tomorrow, or over the next couple weeks. What impact will that have in 5, 10, or 50 years? What will you invest in with your resources (time, money, sweat, relationships)?
7. Pastor Grant said, "Jesus calls followers, not fans." What is the difference?
8. What is the difference between a sinner and a self-righteous person? What is similar between them?
9. What is Jesus' intent of calling you? Is your definition of yourself inline with God's definition of you?

CHALLENGE QUESTIONS:

10. Pastor Grant asked if you allow God's Word to set your heart on fire. Where should that allowance show as being manifest in your life?
